We are looking forward to an exciting day of water sport and fun. The weather forecast is predicting a hot day so we all need to come to school prepared.

The Swimming Carnival is at Blacktown Leisure Centre Stanhope, while the infants will remain at school for the Beach Day.

For students from Year 2 to Year 6 who will be travelling to the Swimming Carnival

Students need to be on time as we will mark our rolls and leave school shortly after morning assembly

Students will need to:

- Wear their full sports uniform and have their swimmers under this
- Wear their school hat
- Bring a plastic bag marked with their name and with their lunch and recess in it
- Have a bottle of water to drink
- Wear sunscreen
- Wear their joggers or thongs
- Bring a beach towel to dry themselves with and to sit on if need be

Students will not be permitted to use the canteen at the pool centre.

For students in Kindergarten and Year 1 who will be remaining at school

for the Infants Beach Day

Students are required to wear

- full sports school uniform for the day (including closed in shoes)
- to participate in water based activities students are allowed to wear their swimmers under their uniform.

Students are also required to bring in a bag:

- A hat to be worn the whole day.
- Sunscreen (that has already been applied)
- Dry Shirts/ Boardshorts to get changed into if needed
- A beach towel (to lay on later that day during the movie)
- Flip Flops/ Sandals to wear during the activities.

Thank you to all parents who have volunteered to assist on the day.

Parents are more than welcome to come along to the swimming carnival and support the students as they race.

School Opal Card - Bus Applications

Applications for 2018 School Student Transport are now open. In coming days students who hold a School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) and are changing grade bands i.e. going from year 2 to 3, or year 6 to 7 <u>and changing school</u> or students whose entitlement was approved under a medical condition, will receive notification by email or post informing them of the pending expiry of their entitlement.

Student enquiring about pending cancellation should be advised to go online to https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails to update details / make application for next year's entitlement.

Application needs to be made before December 2017 to ensure their entitlement updated and their current card is not cancelled. If application is made after the expiry of their entitlement (31 December) the system will automatically

cancel their card and a new one will need to be issued. Students in the Opal area applying for the first time will receive their card (posted to nominated address) a week or two before the commencement of 2018 classes.

Please note: Students who are changing grade band and are remaining at the same school will not receive notification and <u>do not need to reapply</u> as the system now automatically validates a student's on-going eligibility.

Wake up! Jesus is Here Right Now!

Gospel in Life

Stop and think. Do you ever feel alone when you need help with a problem? Do you ever doubt whether your life really makes a difference? A lot of young people often feel isolated or unimportant.

If you have ever had those feelings, pay attention to Jesus' words: 'Be alert! Watch!' Jesus wants you to know that God's help is staring you right in the face. His mission for you is right in front of you.

During Advent we join with Christians all around the world to remember that God sent Jesus once and will send him again at the world's end. Why? Because we need him. We need his help because life is just too hard sometimes. We need his vision because we sometimes miss the work he wants us to do in this messed-up world.

Unfortunately, life gets so busy that we often miss the many ways Christ tries to comfort us or send us to others. Advent is a great time to slow down and be watchful. When you hurt, be alert; Christ is sending people to help you. Pray for help to see them and the humility to accept their help. When others hurt, Christ wants to send you. Like the servants in this week's reading, Christ has important work for you to do in healing this broken world. Pray for help to see those people whose lives you can change.

Take these four weeks of Advent to pray more often. Actively look for how Christ loves you and needs you. Let Advent remind you that Jesus really comes into the world every day. But we miss that unless we watch for Christ, accept Christ's love, and help others in Christ's name.

When I look at the people in my daily life, who are the ones Christ is sending to help me, and who are the ones Christ is showing me I could help?
