Welcome Back

This week we welcome the students, parents and staff back to commence Term 3. Term 3 marks the beginning of Semester 2. This means we are halfway through the school year with the end of 2019 fast approaching.

We finished Term 2 with Parent Interviews. This was a time for teachers to share individual student progress with parents and seek parental information for future learning focuses. Term 3 is typically a time when many things start to come together for students. Teachers build on prior learning from terms 1 and 2 and students make increased connections that accelerate learning.

l would encourage all parents if you have concerns or even a question about your child's learning or well being make a time to discuss this with the class teacher. This can be done by contacting the school office.

This term we are trialing some new ideas in the primary playground. These have been put into place to provide more play options during recess and lunch. It has been reassuring to see more students participating in physical activity and the early feedback from students and staff has been positive. We have already begun planning some additions to the infants playground to add some more choice.

We are also in the process of moving the school garden to a new area. The garden's current location has never delivered good results due to the amount of shade. The new location behind ES1 gets more sun and makes

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good use of an unused part of the playground. The old garden space will be refitted with more details shared throughout the term.

Over the holidays a number of maintenance issues were addressed. These include;

- Fixing Stage 1's floor.
- Fixing a number of doors throughout the school.
- Sealing two unused doorways in ES1.
- Removal of silver seats in the playground to enhance safety
- Over the coming weeks a number of additional items will be addressed including;
- Fixing areas of the adventure softfall and synthetic grass area.
- Fixing subfloor issues in the school office area.
- Replacing remaining drain grates with heel proof grates.
- Installing a shade structure and seating at the Kiss and drop off area.

This Term Mr Crothers, Assistant Principal will be taking leave from weeks 7 to 10. Additionally I will be on leave for the first two weeks of Term 4. In my absence Mr Crothers will be the Acting Principal, whilst for the duration of this time Ms Murphy will be the Acting Assistant Principal. I would like to congratulate both Ms Murphy and Mr Crothers for these appointments.

BREAKING NEWS

St Bernadette's have been fortunate to receive a Sporting Schools grant of \$3500 which has given us the opportunity to run two additional sporting programs, both are nationally endorsed and link to curriculum outcomes. The programs will be delivered to the children by accredited coaches during Term 3.

Basketball (Week 3-6) Primary students will participate in a weekly 45 minutes session lead by a Basketball Australia Coach. Aussie Hoops introduces students to basketball with a nationally accredited coaching curriculum and a program consisting of warm-up games, skill activities and modified games.

Touch Football (Week 7-10) All students will participate in a weekly 60 minutes session lead by Touch Football NSW accredited coaches. Touch football is a sport which everyone can play, regardless of age, gender, experience or ability. The sport creates a social environment which few sports can rival and families can even play together in weekly competitions. The inclusive nature of Touch Football ensures there is a 'place on the field for everyone'.

If your child turns 5 before 31st July 2020 he / she is eligible to enrol for Kindergarten.



The week will be a fun-filled week with a special emphasis on books and reading.




