

# School Opal Card

Applications for the 2021 School Opal Card are now open.

A new or updated application for school travel passes is only needed when a student is:

- applying for a school travel pass for the first time
- requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation eg (joint custody)
- changing school or campus
- changing home address
- receiving an expiry notification
- repeating a school year
- changing their name or requesting a new transport operator

This means students who are progressing to Year 3 and year 7 only need to reapply if they are changing circumstances. To apply or update your child's details <a href="www.transportnsw.info/school-students">www.transportnsw.info/school-students</a>.

Applications need to be submitted before the end of Term 4. School Opal Cards will be mailed out to the student's nominated postal address from January 2021.
