Principal's Message

This week we welcome Mr Galea, our Acting Assistant Principal for the remainder of 2021 and for the duration 2022. Mr Galea is replacing Mrs Buenaventura who has commenced Maternity Leave. Mr Galea will be working hard to familiarise himself with the St Bernadette's community and how we operate. Mr Galea will appreciate your patience during this transition time.

Kindergarten Transition starts next week on Tuesday. Transition will commence at 9am and conclude at 11am. Parents will be restricted to the Parish Hall and must adhere to all COVID safety protocols. This will be an exciting time for our 2022 kindergarten students and their parents.

As the term rapidly comes to a close we are concentrating on maintaining routines and expectations across the school. We would appreciate parents supporting positive student behaviour at school. Typically as the term comes to a close students become restless, but our expectations remain consistent. Reminders about being good friends, turn taking, doing your best and following directions are good discussion points for families.

The return to school has seen an inconsistent approach to wearing the full school uniform. I understand this given the interrupted year. However, I would ask that all students adhere to the uniform expectations as much as possible. Moving into 2022 students will be expected to be wearing full school uniforms at all times. The uniform shop is now taking bookings for parents or alternatively you can complete online orders.

For the last three months we have been working on constructing our new space behind Stage 2. The majority of the work is now complete and the space is now available for use by the students. This is a learning space. We will reveal more details in the coming weeks once the space is officially blessed and opened by Father Andrew.

COVID Safety

Whilst on the school grounds parents are reminded that they must adhere to COVID safety expectations. This includes pick up times in the top playground or coming into the school office. Parents must be double vaccinated and wear a mask at all times.



Step 2 Register
