SEMESTER TWO REPORTS

Staff are currently in the process of finalising Semester Two Student Progress Reports. The purpose of a student progress report is to present the teacher's view of how a student is developing over a period of time and possible next steps for learning.

At St Bernadette's we use a collaborative approach to writing reports. This means that all teachers in a learning space are actively involved in providing learning data that is used to inform student reports.

This week teachers are peer reviewing each others reports. In this process teachers read each others reports to ensure grades and comments align and that there is a consistent understanding of individual student progress shared by all staff involved in the teaching process.

Next week all student reports will be reviewed and validated by the school's Leadership Team. During this process reports will be read with a different lens, one based on Leadership's understanding of student progress.

Our process aims to ensure that we accurately capture student learning progress. It is also envisaged that reports inform parents but don't surprise them. If you have any concerns about your child's progress you are encouraged to contact your child's class teacher.

2023 CLASSES

Currently staff are working on finalising data that will help to determine classes for 2023. We will announce 2023 class teachers and student placements in week 10. Currently we are still sourcing teachers for 2023. It is a challenging time to find teachers and this process is certainly taking longer than usual with less applicants.

We have received another delivery of RAT Test Kits and have sent them home with the students today.

This Sunday is the beginning of Advent. Advent is the period of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ at Christmas.
