I hope you all had a good break with your families and friends! The holidays are overwhelmingly a good time for most of our families, however there are some in our community who have had a challenging time over the break. At this time I would like to extend my prayers and thoughts to those in our community who are experiencing hardship and ask that our families do likewise.

During the holidays maintenance work was carried out including;

- painting student toilets, the library, all doors and railings throughout the school.
- concreting works to rectify trip hazards
- painting to establish outside calm spaces

The painting has been done at considerable expense to the school and I ask that you talk to your children about respecting our spaces and not writing on walls or scratching new paint. Learning Focus

This term staff have been given the challenge to maximise small group reading opportunities in all learning spaces. As staff we understand the importance of students learning to read and applying comprehension skills to interpret texts. This focus includes targeted professional learning for staff to refine how they teach students to read and comprehend texts. We have communicated an ambitious timeline to our staff and have a number of system supports in place. Parents can help by reading with their children each and every night. This is the one aspect of homework that shouldn't be missed and has a significant impact on student reading progress.

I will be on LSL for the last four weeks of term. My leave will commence on Monday the 29th of August and I will return at the start of Term 4.

In my absence Kathryn Newman has been appointed as the Acting Principal. Mrs Newman is currently the Assistant Principal at St John the Apostle, Winston Hills. I thank Mrs Newman for accepting the position and supporting the community of St Bernadette's whilst I am on leave.

Ambrose staff attended our PBS4L staff professional learning on Monday and have committed to implementing this model into the service. OOSH remains separate from the school but we are looking forward to having greater input into the service and how it supports our students.

This week we have welcomed our new school counselor, Veronika Poljak. Veronika has spent the week being inducted into her new role and spending time to understand the school and it's needs. Next week she will be spending time with our previous counselor, Emilie to do an official handover before reaching out to specific families to discuss needs.
